After carrying out regular military service in 1992 he attended at the School "Arts and Crafts" in Vicenza, a course on "Modeling wax."

In 1995 the above mentioned Institute hired him as teacher for the modelling wax, a role that he played also collaborating with colleagues teaching goldsmith and stones setting.

In 2001, after six years as full-time teacher, he was employed as modeller by GoldItalia in Cavazzale (VI), company manufacturing silver jewels that has also received various awards for their innovative design.

Meanwhile, beginning from the 1994, he was also working as freelance for various companies, as consultant designer and modeller. Moreover, he never stopped to teach in several professional schools and also at the moment he's working for the School of Arts and Crafts. In 2007 he decided to open, together with Diego Zaupa, with whom he was already collaborating for many years, the "Nuovo Studio Creativo Associato Zaupa / Speranza".
